Call to register as a support services provider

The National Advisory Council on Innovation (NACI) is a statutory body mandated to advise the government on matters pertaining to innovation (including science and technology; for further information, please visit the NACI website at: www.naci.org.za). NACI maintains a very small administrative infrastructure and from time to time has to buy-in support services, such as publication editing, design and printing, event organisation and related services from outside. These services are obtained on a contract basis. The database of potential support service providers is currently being updated. Organisations and groups, specialising in technical and administrative support services, such as those mentioned above, are invited to register on the NACI database. The information required for registration should include the following details:

- Name and address of the organisation or group
- Organisation profile, e.g. types of service, products and capacity
- Scope and depth of expertise and areas of specialisation
- List of at least three current and/or recent clients
- Proof of commitment to capacity building and empowerment
