Dr Charity Mbileni-Morema is the managing director at NM Envirotech Solutions: responsible for advisory services, project management, capacity building and project development in the green economy space for inclusive growth.

Prior to this, Dr Mbileni-Morema was a senior manager responsible for Green and Sustainable Development Projects at the Innovation Hub.
